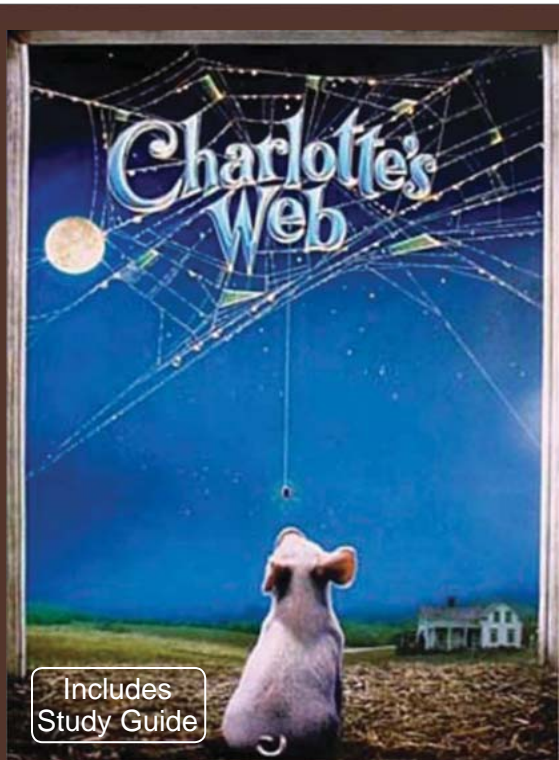


Something Old...

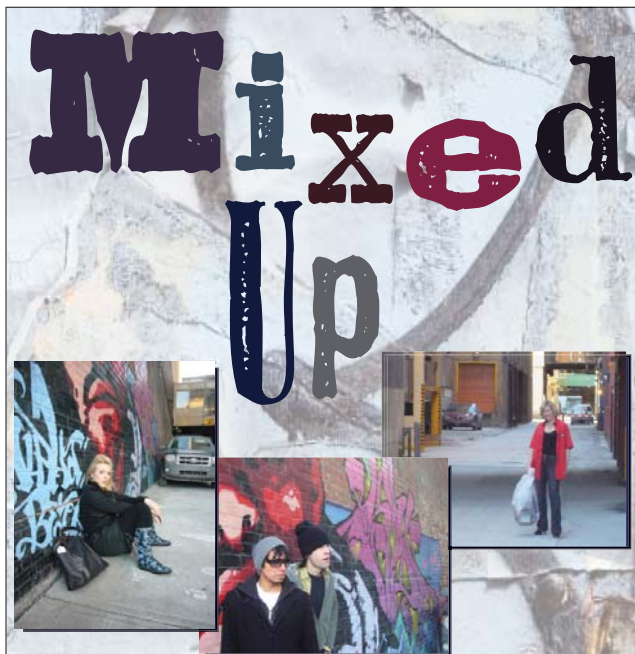

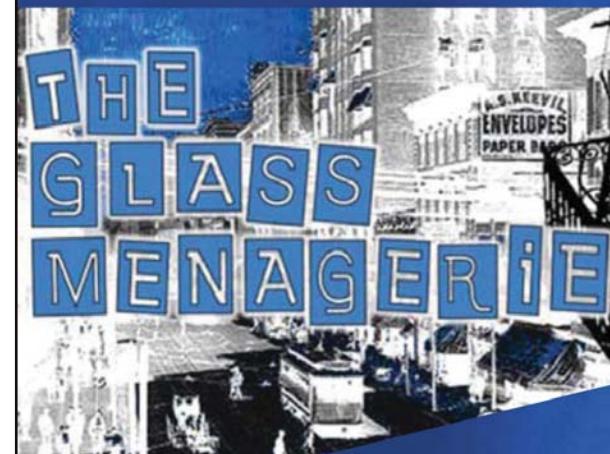
